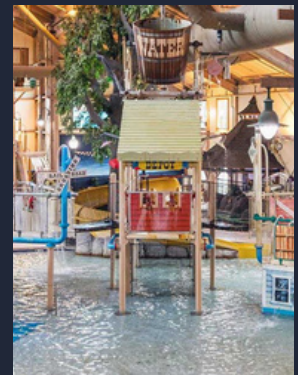

  - teams rostering 4-6 players with an assigned coach
  - TOPSoccer staff will assign players to teams prior to event so pre-registration will be required to facilitate balanced teams
  - all TOPSoccer players age 12+ are welcome to participate
  - should we not be able to roster 4 complete teams of TOPSoccer players, staff will recruit partner players and create unified teams
- **Saturday, December 28:** TOPSoccer will have a table with other vendors on premises to promote our program and bring awareness to the greater soccer community
  - there will be a number of soccer activities for individual players to experience; speed gun to test the power of your shot, target practice, agility skills and other games
  - **UGLY SWEATER SOCIAL** for all ages...join in the fun of the skills games being offered. Special Holiday Drink and Food will be offered in the facility Cafe

Team Bryce started in 2007 with 8 runners/walkers in the Annual Briggs & Al's Run & Walk to benefit Children's Hospital of Wisconsin. The team was inspired by Kevin's son, Bryce, who is disabled. By 2015 Team Bryce grew to over 374 runners/walkers making it the largest single "team" entry in the Briggs & Al's event the past four years.

- Providing children with physical disabilities and their families the opportunity to achieve their full potential
- To encourage and support their full participation in community life
- To promote positive awareness of children with physical disabilities.
